Inclusion - No report; Meeting on Wednesday 2/15

Marketing – Met today; the committee is working with the Inclusion Committee to develop a logo for the MQP Inclusion Handbook. The committee is also freshening up pictures for marketing purposes (Students & School).

Security – The committee continues to evaluate additional safety measures that can be put in place for the building while working on additional Grant funding.
