Blessings! To address the needs and wishes of our families, I am pleased to introduce the following after school programs. For the next semester, beginning January 8th, the following after school classes will be offered; COCA Theatre for grades 1-3 on Mondays, Master Kim Ty Kwon Do for grades 1-8 on Tuesdays, Palmer Music Keyboard and Introduction to Music for grades 1-3 on Thursdays. In addition, two after school classes will continue for next semester, Legos for grades 1-4 on Monday afternoons and chess on Wednesday afternoons. These classes will begin after school the week of January 8th and will continue through spring break, for about 8 weeks.

The Y-Club through the YMCA will still be an option. If needed, a family may register with the YMCA to take advantage of their drop in or walk in service. Any kindergarten – 8th grader, who is registered with the YMCA, may use their drop in service. This is a great option especially for the above mention classes that end before a parent can pick their children. More information about Y-Club is available in the school office.

Our beloved kindergarten teacher and former preschool teacher, Mrs. Kelley Breihan, is offering enrichment classes for our preschoolers – kindergarteners. Her theme centered classes will begin on Monday, January 8. The classes will begin afterschool each day and end at 4:15.

Registration for After School Classes

To register your child for any of the classes, complete the attached form. Please return this form, along with a check or checks made payable to the provider(s) of the classes to the school office no later than December 21, 2017.

The classes will be filled on a first to register basis. We do expect all of the classes to fill to capacity, so please return your registration forms with the payment checks next week. Registration will not be processed until completed forms and payment is received. Those parents who return completed registration forms with payment will receive an email from Mr. Nieman within a few days after December 21st to confirm that their registration has been completed and confirmed.

Every parent who registers their child will be required to volunteer for at least one of the classes during the eight week session. They will assist the children arriving for the class and leaving, along with anything that the children might need during the class. This will enable the instructors to focus on teaching the class. We will have a parent volunteer schedule for each class, with the goal of having one parent volunteer present. Volunteers need to have taken Protecting God's Children and their certification needs to on file with Mrs. Heather O'Keefe in the parish office. Mrs. Kelley Breiham does not need a parent volunteer.

Our vision is that there will be another subsequent registration for after school classes during the second half of next semester. If you have any questions about any of the after school classes or about the registration process, please contact Mr. Nieman.

Again, if you would like to register your child for any of these after school classes, please return this completed form to the Mary, Queen of Peace school office by December 21st along with checks included made payable to the class providers. Registrations will be completed on a first to register with full payment basis.

() **Mondays - Fridays: Preschool – Kindergarten After School Club**, 3:00 to 4:30 pm. This engaging class is for students in grades preschool - kindergarten. Children will participate in a variety of theme related activities. Through Religion, art, games, dramatic play, music, free play, story telling, and STREAM, the children will engage in enriching activities. Parents have the option to register their child for one or multiple days. Each day will need a minimum of 3 students for each day to proceed and will have a maximum of 20 students. The fees are \$12.00 per student for each class. The fees also include healthy snacks. Mrs. Kelley Breiham is currently a kindergarten teacher and former preschool teacher. She is also certified to teach the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. To register for this class, please check the box for this paragraph, complete the information section and return this form, along with a check payable to Mrs. Kelley Breiham for the number of days chosen within an eight week period, to the school office by December 21st.

() **Mondays: COCA Curtains Up Theatre Class**, 3:00 to 4:05 pm: <http://www.cocastl.org/>. This class is for students in grades 1-3. Young performers will learn to use the body and voice to create characters. Using improvisation, dramatic play, story enactment and theatre games, students will develop confidence as they discover the joy of theatre. The class will need 8 minimum registered students to proceed and will have a maximum of 14 students. The fees are \$160 per student for the 8 weeks between January and spring break. COCA has provided an excellent teacher for this class who has her PhD in theatre and many years of experience teaching theatre. information section and return this form, together with a check payable to COCA for \$160 to the school office by December 21st.

() **Mondays: Legos Class**, 3:00 to 4:05 pm: This class is for students in grades 1-4. The fees are \$87 per student for the 8 weeks from January through spring break in March. Bricks 4 Kidz Early Engineers: Students build machines, buildings, vehicles and other structures out of motorized LEGO bricks. This class will be continuing from last semester with the same instructor. To register for this class, please check the box for this paragraph and return this form, complete the information section and return this form and return it to the school office by December 21st. () **Tuesdays: Ty Kwon Do, Master Kim**, 3:00 to 4:05 pm: <http://www.masterkimskma.com/>. This class is for students in grades 1-8. This class requires a minimum of ten students to proceed. With 20 or more students, this class will be divided into an older class section and a younger class section with Master Kim and an assistant as the instructors. The fees are \$115 per student for 8 weeks from January through spring break in March. Master Kim is a Korean martial arts expert and is the owner of his training center in Warson Woods, which provides many weekly martial arts classes for children. Master Kim is currently teaching an after school Ty Kwon Do class at Our Lady of Pillar. To register for this class, please check the box for this paragraph and return this form, complete the information section and return to it to Mary, Queen of Peace's school office, with a check payable to Master Kim Kum Sung Martial Arts for \$115, by December 21st. Master Kim requests that each student wear a martial arts outfit, which he will provide for \$50. To purchase one, please add another \$50 to your registration fee for a total of \$165. Master Kim will bring the martial arts outfits for the children on the first day of class, January 9th. He will have all sizes available.

() **Wednesdays: Chess class 3:00-4:15 pm**: Mrs. Suzanne Moore is the parent coordinator for this class. This class is continuing from last semester. New students are welcome and encouraged to join the class for next semester. To extend your child's registration from last semester or to register a new student for the class for next semester beginning in January, please email Suzanne Moore at suzjgau@yahoo.com. This class will continue for all of the spring semester. A separate flyer will also be sent home regarding Chess club. You do not need to complete this form if you are only registering for the chess class.

() **Thursdays: Palmer Music Keyboard/ Piano and Introduction to Music, 3:00-4:05 pm**: This class will be for students in grades 1-3. The fees will be \$175 for the 8 week period between January and spring break. This class is also expected to continue for a second 8 week session in the spring semester. The instructors for this class will be Ms. Seyfried and Mr. Palmer. Palmer Music currently also provides supplementary music classes for students during the day at Mary Queen. Each student will need to have a keyboard for the class, which can be purchased from Palmer Music for \$173.77, including tax, for the keyboard and carrying case. To register for this class, please check the box for this paragraph, complete the information section and return this form, together with a check payable to Palmer Music for \$175 to the school office

by December 21st. To purchase a keyboard for the class, please include another check payable to Palmer Music for \$173.77 for the keyboard and carrying case with this returned registration form. Mr. Palmer will bring the purchased keyboards for the students on the first day of class, 1/11.
