

Summary of Minutes from 9/12/16 MQP BOE Meeting

Prior Minutes: Approved August Minutes.

Committee Reports:

Middle School Initiative Update: Members of the Middle School committee are putting together a bulletin board for the back of church.

EM&M: Members are being recruited for the committee. On December 5th there will be a preschool and kindergarten prospective parent open house.

Technology: Bids are being gathered for a new server and Wi-Fi for the school/church campus.

Inclusion: MQP has gotten good press on the inclusion program. A new consultant has been hired for the program and Nicolette Gibson from KC Fire program is coming for a visit. The inclusion committee is in the process of developing a mission statement.

BOE Training: The Board reviewed the highlights of the BOE training session.

beOne Program: This program is an initiative of the archdiocese and is a framework for parishes to focus on what is important – the 4 Pillars. MQP is tasked with evaluating its ministries to see if there is sufficient focus on the 4 Pillars. MQP must report back to the Archdiocese next June.

Principal's Update:

Start of School: The new class policy was well received. All grades started on the same day this year. On the Friday before the start of school, the preschool teachers were available for meet and greet with students and parents before the buddy family gathering.

Grandparent's day: The plans for Grandparent's day are being finalized.

Pastor's Update:

Beyond Sunday Campaign: This is an Archdiocese capital campaign to fund Catholic education. The goal is \$100 Million and \$65 Million has been raised so far. MQP's goal is \$2.2 Million. 60% of the funds raised will go to the Archdiocese and 40% will go to the Parish. The money will fund scholarship grants and technology and resources for schools. Of the funds going to MQP 50% will be used for scholarships and 50% will be used for parish ministries and the capital repair fund.
