Grade Level Goals and Content

**GRADE: 2**

**SUBJECT: Art**

**GOALS:** Given the nature of Art Education there is no straight progression of art. The levels will vary and overlap one another in sequence.

Students will engage in a qualitative exploration of:

1. art history.
2. art making ( production ).
3. art criticism ( analysis ).
4. art aesthetics ( judgement ).

**CONTENT TOPICS:**

1. History (artists, styles, time periods, and cultures)
2. Art elements and principles (line, shape, color, texture, value, form, space, variety, rhythm, and balance)
3. Art media and processes [tempera paint, water color (color mixing and mono-prints), oil pastels ( blending), rubbings, crayon resist, modeling materials, paper, manipulation and construction (curling, folding, and joining methods)]
4. Two-dimensional imagery [drawing and painting projects on units of landscape, figure, portraits, still-life and non-objective art (design), decorative arts and architecture]
5. Three-dimensional forms (sculpture)
6. Equipment and art material safety (appropriate use and care of scissors, brushes, paint containers, aprons and drawing instruments)
