

Health Information for Enrollment Mary Queen of Peace School

All students entering preschool, kindergarten, 3rd, and 6th grades for 2021-2022 school year will need a new physical form on file before they start school. All new students entering other grades will need a physical form on file also. The student will be excluded from school until the physical exam is completed and the form is returned. The physical should be performed in the 12-month period before school starts. The physical form is due August 10, 2021. Please do not wait until the summer to make your appointment because doctors get booked early for summer check-ups. Physicals done now are acceptable for the coming school year.

All immunizations must be up to date. For incoming kindergarten students, please turn in their physical form after they have received their 5-year shots. They must have state required immunizations before entering kindergarten. All immunizations must include the month, day, and year and should come from the doctor's office. Unfortunately, we cannot accept immunizations schedules written by parents. A Tdap is now required for students entering 8th grade. If your child is not required to turn in a physical form for the coming school year, please turn in any updates on immunizations or a medical condition. Please make sure the medical history section of the form is filled out. A medication permission form is provided in the Document Upload area. This form must be signed by the parent and the doctor for the student to receive any medication at school. This includes all over the counter medication such as Tylenol, Advil, cough medicine, antacids, etc. The permission form saves time when administering Tylenol or Advil for a headache or minor ailment, so we do not have to call the parent to come to school and give the medication or have an order faxed from the doctor. Please note that a new form is required every year. The doctor may use his/her own form, it does not have to be a school form. All medications must be sent in their original container. We cannot accept medication in a Ziploc bag. Please do not send medications to school without a permission form on file and filled out by the doctor.

All students who require the use of an Epi-pen or inhaler need to have an asthma action plan or food allergy action plan filled out and on file before the start of school. The form can be found in the Document Upload area. A new form needs to be completed every year. Please make sure all Epi-pens and inhalers are brought to school before the first day.
